## YAP Research – User Group Registration

The Youth Activity Profile is an online tool designed to facilitate the assessment and promotion of physical activity in youth<sup>1</sup>. It is designed for school-based applications and offers potential for school-based research, public health surveillance applications, or as an audit tool to promote Comprehensive School Physical Activity Programs (CSPAP). The YAP is available for free for schools in the U.S. that are enrolled in the Active Schools initiative (<https://yap.activeschoolsus.org/>), but a separate YAP tool is available for research and international applications ([www.youthactivityprofile.org](http://www.youthactivityprofile.org)).

Information about the utility and validity of the YAP is housed on a separate website ([www.yapresearch.org](http://www.yapresearch.org)). Ongoing research efforts are coordinated by a distributed network of researchers that share an interest in the tool for school – based applications.
